

ASSESSMENT DAY

Teachers will be sending home links to signup for assessment day on August 23rd. This is a required day that students must come to school for 15-20 minutes to work one-on-one with their teacher. Fourth and fifth grade students will have an Interview time with their teacher, allowing the teachers to get to know what makes their students tick.
