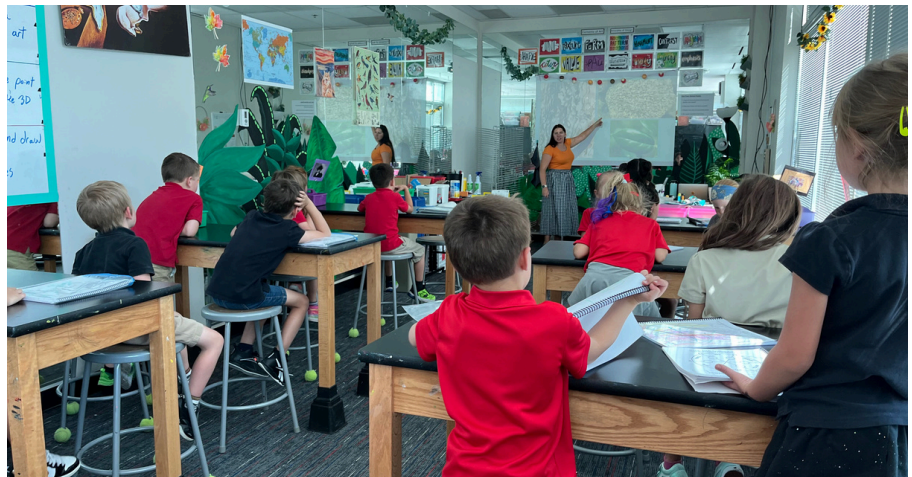


ELEMENTARY SPECIALS

As you know Addenbrooke is committed to music and physical education daily. We also have four other specials that we offer for our K-5 students.

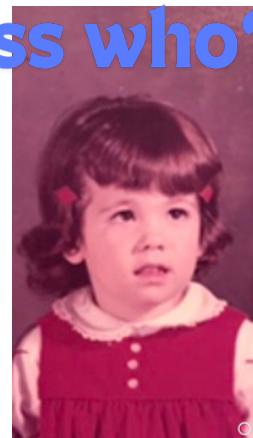

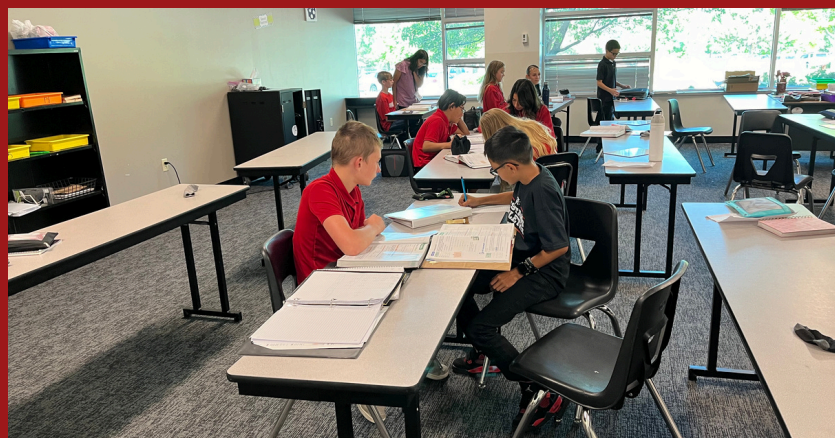
