



Highlighted items from the previous month.

1. Job descriptions and responsibilities have changed for Evelyn Fiadonu and Shawn Spencer. Mrs. Fiadonu will be in charge of finance and HR and Mr. Spencer will be in charge of buildings/grounds and security. He has also been helping with contact tracing.
2. Two enrollment events were held in November. A PreK-12 event for general enrollment was held on November 16th. 35 people were in attendance. An 8th grade enrollment event was held on November 30th in our High School Commons. Over 60 people were in attendance.
3. Parenting Safe Kids is a program offered for educators and families concerning sexual abuse and how to protect our families. Several parents have spoken to me about this. Please see the attached information in your packet.
4. An IT company has been contacted to help us with computer issues. We have entered into a contract for 20 hours a month of IT assistance.
5. Outdoor lab has been booked for November 2022 at Camp IdRaHaJe.

We are beginning to call the families of Addenbrooke to partner with us as we work toward providing an outstanding Classical education for their students. In light of this mission, each family with an 8th grade student received a handwritten invitation from members of our National Honor Society to attend the 8th grade enrollment event. I called each family to remind them of the event and personally invited all of them. We had over 60 people in attendance at the information meeting. Six of our High School students presented at the event to outline why Addenbrooke has been a good fit for them.

During the Week of December 6th, our student musicians from K-12 performed their holiday concerts. Three were held in the Addenbrooke Gymnasium. The High School concert was performed at Southwest Community Church. The 8th grade honors choir and orchestra joined the High School in their concert. There were over 600 audience members at each event.
