Highlights:

- 156 people attended "A Christmas Carol" at the Denver Center for Performing Arts, followed by a student government-led social that afternoon.
- Our Mustang Chorale performed at the Golden Candlelight Walk last Friday night.
- The National Honor Society members are holding a toy drive to benefit the Denver Dream Center.
- The 8th grade parent information night was very well attended. Six upperclassmen were present and encouraged families with their perspective on why Addenbrooke is the right school for them.

Things we are working on:

- As of last Monday, students have 50 F's. This is mostly due to missing assignments. Parents were called and students encouraged to attend after-school help this week to recover the grade before finals.  
We are continuing to utilize the MTSS (Multi-tiered system of supports) and AST (Academic Support Team) teams.  
An ASH (After-school help) spreadsheet was created for each teacher listing their students who should be attending, whether they attended, and what was worked on, this will aid in increased communication between the MTSS team and teachers.  
The faculty and staff are going to discuss strategies to cut down on missing assignments during in-service on Jan. 4.
- We have hired a math interventionist to assist in Algebra I. The ninth grade class is challenging, as we knew they would be from their time in middle school, and this hire is necessary to help them master the content, with special emphasis on number and quantity.
- There are continuing behavior issues with one student. We are working with Mom and the district to determine the best course of action to help this student.
