


Dear Students & Parents,

A NOTE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

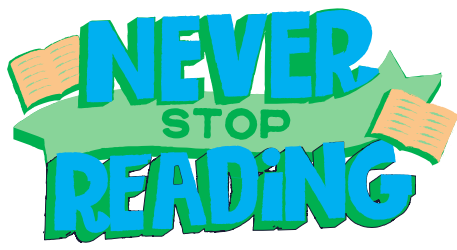
Reflecting on a Wonderful School Year

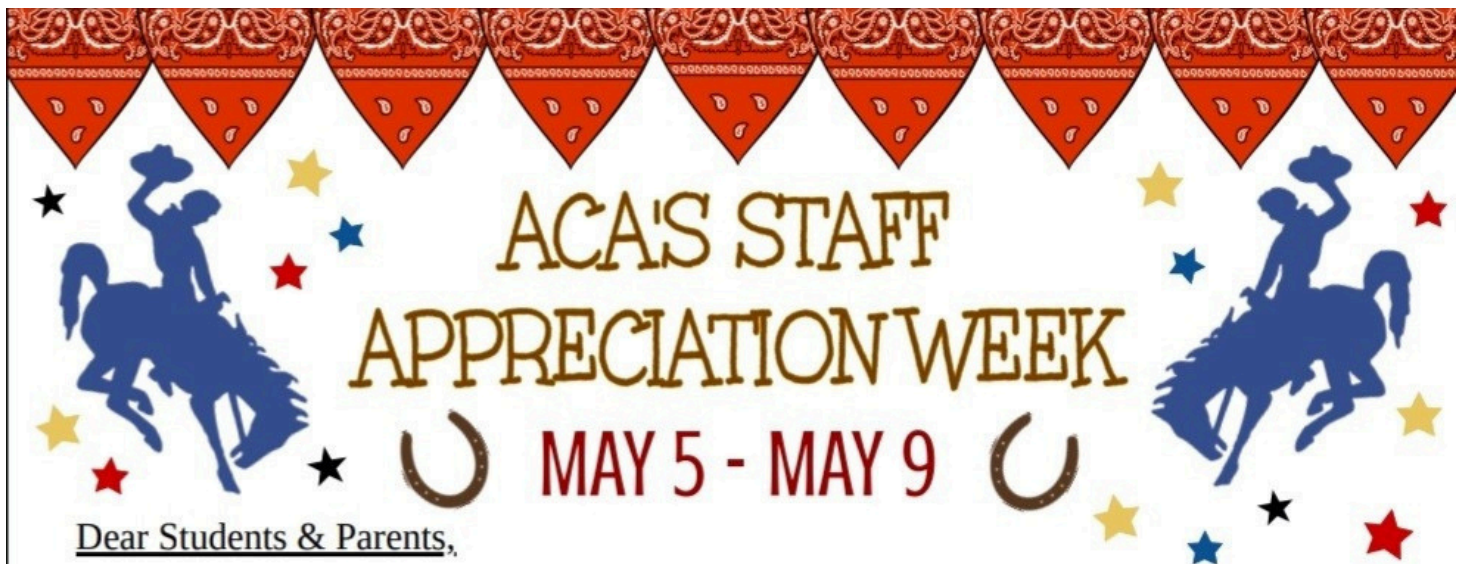

We rounded up your favorite snacks and drinks for you cowpokes

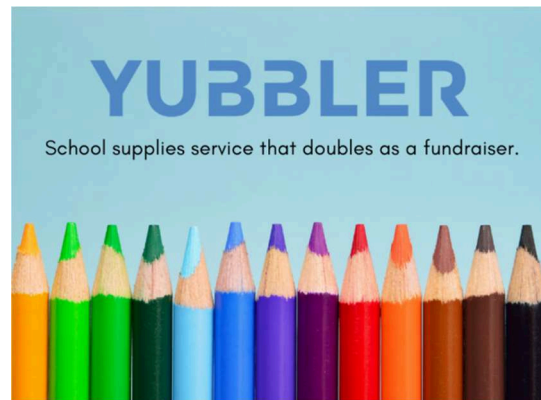
