Dear Parents,

We made it to summer vacation; I hope your students are enjoying their first week! I am attaching various information you will need to purchase supplies for the 23/24 school year: dress code, supply list and literature book list. I have also included the updated student handbook, the 2023/2024 Year at a Glance Calendar, and the Summer School flier.

Also, now that second semester grades are final, if your student needs credit recovery they can attend in-person for free at Lakewood, Columbine, Arvada West or Conifer, at home online with Jeffco Virtual Academy, or, for a \$99 fee, at home online with Educere.

It is my understanding that with the in-person summer school, you may choose two classes and students will attend four days a week. One class will be two days a week.

If your student needs English credit, for Classic Lit - choose English 9, British Lit - choose English 10, American Lit choose English 11. If your student needs history, Classical and Biblical World is replaced with World Geography, Medieval is replaced with World History. All other classes should be self-explanatory.

If you choose to use Educere, it is recommended that they enroll in one class at a time.

The dress code has been simplified to only clothing that is not allowed.

General Guidelines for Clothing Not Allowed

- **Appropriateness Rule:** Armpit to armpit rule: the student should be able to draw a line from one armpit to the other and have anything below that line covered by clothing: mid-drifts, halter tops, backless, strapless, tube tops, spaghetti strap, or muscle shirts are not allowed.
- **Length Rule:** nothing shorter than cell phone width above the knee.
- **Fabric Rule:** No inappropriately sheer or stretchy fabrics, fishnet, net or similar material; leggings, yoga pants, flare stretchy pants, sweat pants or athletic stretch pants are not allowed.
- **Accessory Rule:** Hats, bandanas, beanies, or hoods are not allowed, no dark/sunglasses, no blankets
- **No paraphernalia, grooming, jewelry, accessories, or body adornments that are symbols, words, slogans, patches, or pictures that:**

- Refer to drugs, tobacco, alcohol or weapons
- By virtue of color arrangement, trademark, or other attribute denote membership in gangs, advocate drug use, violence, porn, or disruptive behaviors
- Are obscene, sexual, profane, vulgar, lewd, or slanderous
- Promote any activity prohibited by the student code of conduct
- No graphic tees or hoodies (exception: Addenbrooke, college, military, Colorado, or US theme)
- Otherwise disrupt the teaching-learning process.
