As a reminder, if you are exempt for personal reasons, please be sure to complete the online [Immunization Education Module](#) from CDPHE and submit the certificate of completion as this is an annual requirement for personal exemptions.

If you have an upcoming appointment for your student to address immunizations please let us know as this is considered "in process" and we will gladly accept the updated record upon completion.
