The School Accountability Committee (SAC) is a statutory committee, whose objective is to represent the school community's vision by providing opportunities for parent and community members to be involved in the planning and evaluation of the school's quality improvement processes. SAC executes an annual parent satisfaction survey to determine community needs and concerns, and it makes recommendations to the school's executive director and the principal(s), to be used in the development of the school's Unified Improvement Plan (UIP).

Our SAC is composed of parents of students enrolled in the school, community members, Addenbrooke's teachers, a member of PACS, and a representative from our leadership team.

The duties of SAC do **NOT** include budgeting or financial decision making, personnel issues, individual student discipline issues, any issue dealing with a specific student, staff member, or parent.
