### KEYBOARDING

For the next 6 weeks in 2nd through 5th grade we will be learning and practicing our keyboard skills.

In 3-5th grades will be using Typing Club.

Each student should be able to get a minimum of 15 minutes of practice each week in class. Students can access their accounts in class and at home.

If students do not complete their practice time during Library/Technology they will need to make it up at home or in their classroom.

Students can see how long they have practiced by logging in to their typing club accounts. A link to the site is found here.

Students signing in through their Addenbrooke Google accounts should have their passwords to sign in saved in that account.

I will give typing grades based on practice time.

After 6 weeks they should have at least 11/2 hours of practice at 15 minutes a week.

This will be the grading scale for typing.

80-90+ minutes A 70 - 80 minutes B 60 - 70 minutes C

50 - 60 minutes D

Under 50 minutes F

If your student is practicing at home, please make sure they practice using correct fingering. Grades for typing will be given the week after Halloween.


